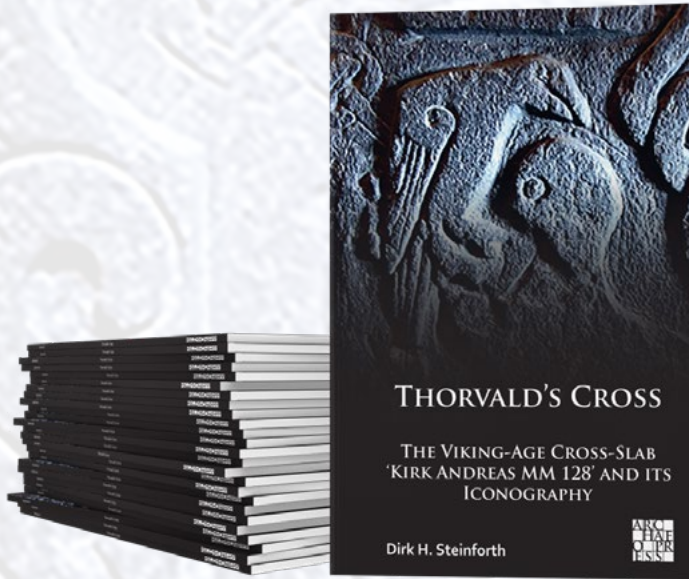

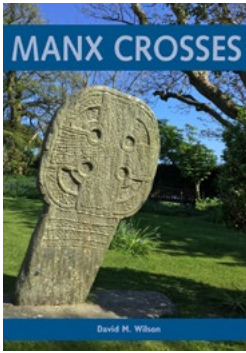

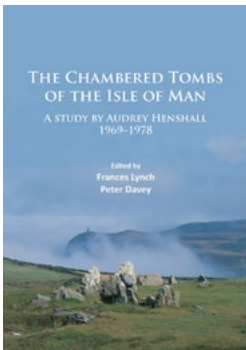
Manx Crosses *A Handbook of Stone Sculpture 500-1040 in the Isle of Man* By David M. Wilson
